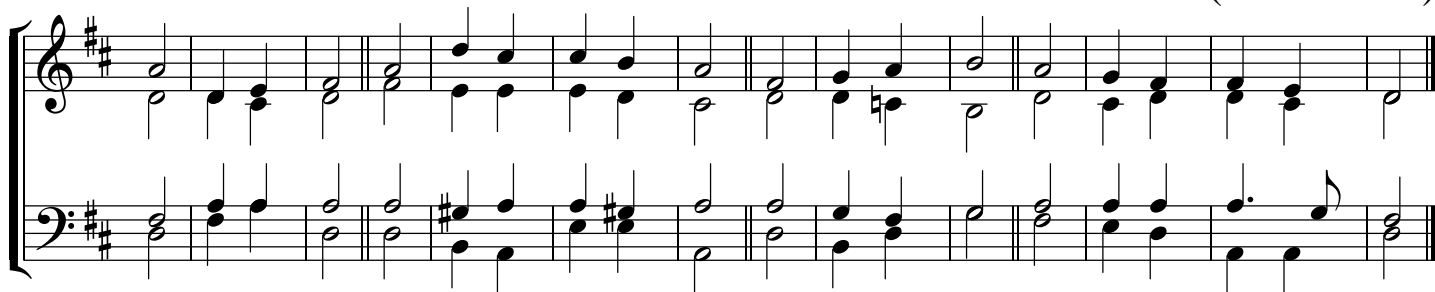


Psalm 34
