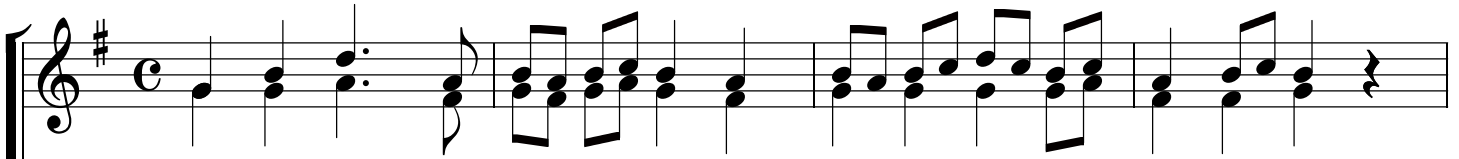

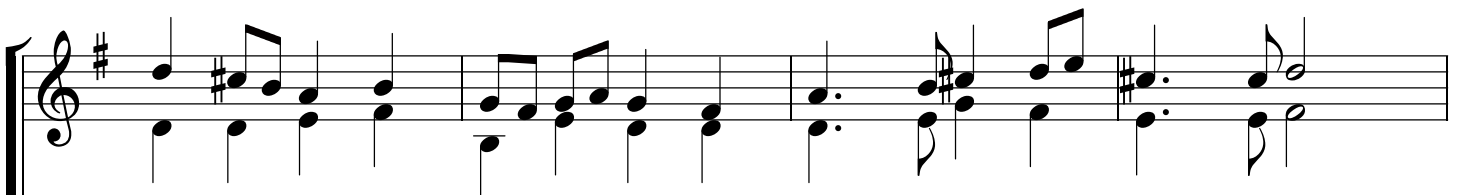
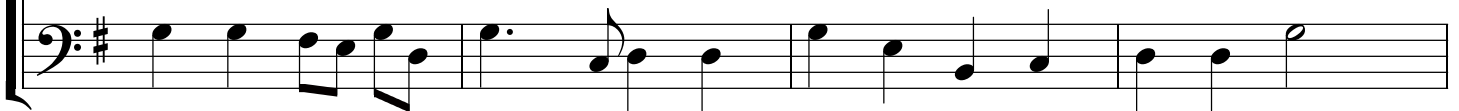
Traditional English Carol

2. Then kind looks with plea-sures beam - ing, Blaz - ing hearth and fes - tive fare;

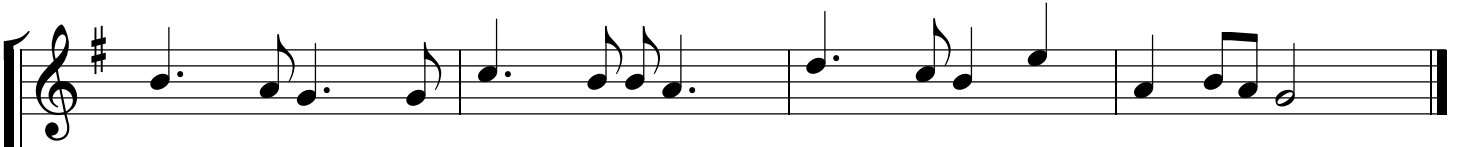


1. Then no room had they for sad - ness, Joy - ous at the Sa - viour's birth.
