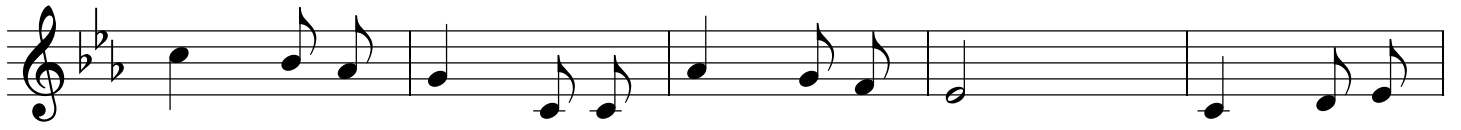


Sing we all merrily, Christmas is here

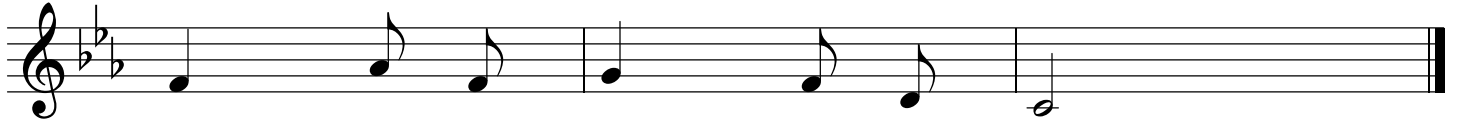
Traditional English carol
